SEASON 2021 OPENING ARRANGEMENTS

Hopefully, and with fingers crossed; and staying safe; and continuing to follow Covid restrictions we are about to open for the new season. So, if you have already renewed your membership or have recently joined our club, you're ready to start trout fishing from the start of the national season for trout on 15 March. Despite the rather chilly weather we though members would benefit from the chance top get "out for trout" from 15 March even though the season for salmon doesn't start until 1 April. So here are the conditions :- **Staying Safe** – bank fishing only, socially distant and following all current Covid safety measures we can travel to fish our local waters. **Fishing methods** – this is fly only tackle for trout from the bank only – no boats out as yet. No booking in is needed until 1 April then all normal club rules will apply so long as national Covid restrictions allow. There are **no visitor tickets** available and **you must have renewed or joined and have your permit card with you when fishing**. The Cromarty Firth Fishery Board water bailiff service are aware of the above conditions and will apply them. Tight Lines – and warm clothes by the looks of the forecast!

2021 MEMBERSHIP UPDATE
